

THE MALL | 12TH JUNE 2016

Guest information - an overview

TIMINGS*

10:00 Gates open

Your ticket will include advice of the nearest gate to access your seat. Once through 'airport-style' security at the gate, you can find your seat (volunteers will be on hand to help!), collect your M&S picnic hamper from the nearest hamper point and a cup of PG tips from one of the tea stations and then settle down at your table to enjoy the day. Ticket holders will be allowed to enter The Mall at any point during the day, but we encourage you to allow sufficient time to pass through security. There is no re-admission to the event.

12:00 Parade starts

The carnival-style parade will keep guests entertained from mid-day. It is divided into segments, each celebrating a decade of Her Majesty The Queen's reign and the categories of her patronage.

14:45 Official proceedings

The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh make their way to the stage at Admiralty Arch from Buckingham Palace for speeches, returning down The Mall followed by the Parade (for the second time).

16:30 Event ends

YOUR TICKET

Your e-ticket will be sent to the email address provided at registration at the end of May and you'll need to bring a printed version of this with you to gain entry. Where an email address has not been provided, the ticket will be printed and posted to the address shown on the ticket.

ID TO BRING WITH YOU

Along with your e-ticket, you'll need to bring two forms of identification, one photographic and one with proof of address that matches the address on your ticket. Important: Should guests arrive without the necessary documentation, they may not be permitted on The Mall.

WHAT YOU CAN BRING ON THE DAY

Due to the nature and scale of the event, everyone will be subject to a full police search, and no bags bigger than personal handbags or daysacks (approx. 15cm x 30cm) will be allowed into the event. People should expect some delay in passing through our search procedures and we thank you for your patience. No organisational branded items, such as flags, banners or inflatables will be allowed on/near the tables. Mobile phones and cameras will be allowed (no selfie sticks) to capture this fantastic experience, restrictions apply, visit www.thepatronslunch.com/event_info for more information.

FOOD AND DRINK

You won't be able to bring any food or drink with you on the day - any you do bring will be taken off you at the gates. However, thanks to our Partners M&S, Unilever and Pimm's, you'll have a great selection of food and refreshments in your individual hamper, which includes lunch and afternoon tea. Complementary tea, water and ice cream will also be available throughout the day. In addition, there will be bars on The Mall where you can purchase more alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks should you wish. There won't be cash points, but all bars will accept credit/debit cards.

WHAT ELSE WILL THERE BE ON THE MALL

As well as the chairs and tables to seat the 10,000 guests, other facilities include PG tips tea stations, Wall's ice-cream trikes, M&S hamper collection points, merchandise stalls, big screens, bars, toilets and first aid stations. Guests will not be expected to remain seated for the duration of the event, but will have the opportunity to get up and walk around.

ENTERTAINMENT

A carnival-style parade, which will begin at Horse Guards Parade and travel along The Mall, turning at the Queen Victoria Memorial, will keep guests entertained from mid-day. The parade will then pass along Birdcage Walk to the south of St James's Park, and will complete the loop twice.

YOUR SEAT

All 10,000 guests will be seated at tables, on individual chairs, the full length of The Mall. You'll find out where your seat is located when you receive your e-ticket at the end of May. As much as possible, guests will be sitting together with similar organisations.

WHAT TO WEAR

There is no formal dress code, we would encourage you to dress appropriately for the weather and as the event is outside, to bring suitable warm clothing just in case. Should it rain, we will have ponchos on hand, and ask you to bring your great British spirit, as the event will go on regardless, unless it is deemed unsafe to continue. There is no coat/baggage storage facility.

THE ROYAL FAMILY

The Queen, The Duke of Edinburgh and other members of the Royal Family will be in attendance on the day.

LIVE BROADCAST

The event will be broadcast live on the BBC, so don't forget to let friends and family know and get them to tune in.

ACCESSIBILITY

All disabled guests are welcomed at The Patron's Lunch and we will try and accommodate all guests' needs where possible. Detailed information will be available soon which will include: Blue badge parking locations, accessible public transport link, drop off areas, potential distances involved, which gates are accessible, locations of accessible toilets and much more.
